## ORDER

Before the Court is the Recommendation of Magistrate Judge Stephen Hyles. (Doc. 90). The Magistrate Judge recommends granting the motion to dismiss filed by Defendants Fowlkes and Cochran because Plaintiff Owens failed to exhaust his administrative remedies. (Doc. 61). Instead of objecting, Owens appealed the Recommendation. (Doc. 100). The Eleventh Circuit dismissed the appeal for lack of jurisdiction. (Doc. 107).
