After screening the Plaintiff's recast complaint (Doc. 18) pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A, United States Magistrate Judge Stephen Hyles ordered the claims against Defendants Reeves and Neff to go forward but recommends transferring the claims against Defendants Dr. Mack and Nurse Michelle to the Northern District of Georgia and dismissing without prejudice the claims against Defendants Nehemiah Ingram and Sheriff Bill Massey.
