¹ The Court notes that the Recommendation simply states that the claims against Masee should be dismissed, which generally connotes a dismissal with prejudice. See *Hickman v. Hickman*, 563 F. App'x 742, 743 (11th Cir. 2014). Dismissal with prejudice, however, is not appropriate here.
