ORDER

Before the Court is a Report and Recommendation from United States Magistrate Judge Richard L. Hodge, filed April 1, 2008. (Doc. 10). It is recommended that Plaintiff's claims against Officer Echoles and Officer White be **DISMISSED**. No objection has been filed to date.¹

Upon full review and consideration of the record, the Court finds that said Report and Recommendation (Doc. 10) should be, and hereby is, **ACCEPTED, ADOPTED** and made the Order of this Court for reason of the findings made and reasons stated therein. ¹ A review of the docket shows that on April 10, 2008, Plaintiff filed a letter addressed to the Court, which does not object to the Report and Recommendation. (Doc. 11). Plaintiff's letter requests information as to the viability of his claims against Officer Bates. The Report and Recommendation filed by Magistrate Judge Hodge does not recommend dismissal of Plaintiff's remaining claim against Officer Bates, therefore, that claim remains pending.
