STIPULATION

In accordance with Court's June 14, 2010 Order, the parties submit herewith, as one docket entry and in paper format, the full current copyright policy of the University System of Georgia (hereinafter, the "Submission"). An Index is provided with the Submission. The Index references Exhibits 1-67. Exhibits 1-15 of the Submission constitute true and correct hard copies of webpages from the University System of Georgia website. Exhibits 16-67 of the Submission constitute true and correct hard copies of webpages that are found at links contained in the webpages at Exhibits 1-15. With reference to the Submission, the parties stipulate as follow:

- (1) Plaintiffs contend that Exhibits 1-6 of the Submission constitute the copyright policy of the University System of Georgia as it applies to Georgia State University ("GSU") and that Exhibits 7-15 constitute relevant information regarding the policy.
- (2) Defendants contend that Exhibits 1-67 of the Submission constitute the full current copyright policy of the University System of Georgia, including all relevant information regarding the policy. Defendants submit that Exhibits 16-67, as linked webpages in Exhibits 1-15, are incorporated by reference and constitute a part of the full current policy of the University System of Georgia. Even if not formally deemed part of the policy, Defendants submit that the linked webpages shown at Exhibits 16-67 constitute relevant information regarding the policy. Thus, Defendants believe that Exhibits 16-67 are responsive to the Court's Order.
- (3) Plaintiffs object to Exhibits 16-67 of the Submission. Plaintiffs contend that these documents constitute no more than the content of numerous third-party websites that is not incorporated in any way into GSU's copyright policy itself and accordingly, has no bearing on the issues currently before this Court.
- (4) Defendants are simultaneously furnishing a paper courtesy copy of this Stipulation and the Submission to the Court.
