ORDER


On August 20, 2010, pursuant to this Court's orders [Docs, 226, 227], Plaintiffs filed a list of each Georgia State University course during the 2009 Maymester, the Summer 2009 semester, or the Fall 2009 semester for which an allegedly infringed work was assigned and included information regarding each alleged infringement during that semester.

Defendants have until August 30, 2010 to respond to this list. The Court issues the following additional instructions to Defendants regarding their response.

Defendants' response should correspond in format to the charts filed by Plaintiffs [Doc. 228]. In other words, Defendants must file a set of "response charts" including the same rows of work titles, grouped by course title and instructor as listed by Plaintiffs, and adding additional columns to each row to include the following: (1) Defendants' objections to the information stated by Plaintiff with regard to each excerpt listed; (2) all books and coursepacks that students were required to purchase for

each course; (3) whether each excerpt listed was required reading for that particular course; (4) how many students were enrolled in each such course during that particular semester; and (5) the total number of courses that were taught in each of the following semesters: Maymester 2009, Spring 2009, and Summer 2009.
