DECLARATION OF WILLIAM ANDREWS

I, William Andrews, do hereby declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. My name is William Andrews. I am over the age of 18 and competent to make this declaration. All of the facts stated herein are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.

2. I am a Senior Academic Advisor for the College of Health and Human Sciences at Georgia State University. My responsibilities include course scheduling and enrollment management for all courses within the College of Health and Human Sciences. As a necessary result of these responsibilities, I have access to the College of Health and Human Sciences' records of courses taught and the number of students enrolled in each course.

3. I understand that Plaintiffs in this case have alleged that certain works were used in certain courses that were taught within the College of Health and Human Sciences during Maymester 2009, Summer 2009, and Fall 2009.

4. I have reviewed the College of Health and Human Sciences courses Plaintiffs allege were taught during Maymester 2009, Summer 2009, and Fall 2009. I have checked each such course against the College of Health and Human Sciences' enrollment records to determine whether its was actually taught.

5. Plaintiffs allege that "SW7300 – Methods of Community Research" was taught by Professor Ohmer during Fall 2009. According to the College of Health and Human Sciences' enrollment records, this course was not taught in Fall 2009.
