**DECLARATION OF SHELLY-ANN WILLIAMS**

I, Shelly-Ann Williams, do hereby declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. My name is Shelly-Ann Williams. I am over the age of 18 and competent to make this declaration. All of the facts stated herein are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.

2. I am the Director of the Office of Academic Assistance for the Andrew Young School of Policy Studies at Georgia State University. My responsibilities include course scheduling and enrollment management for all courses within the School of Policy Studies. As a necessary result of these

responsibilities, I have access to the School of Policy Studies' records of courses taught and the number of students enrolled in each course.

3. I understand that Plaintiffs in this case have alleged that certain works were used in certain courses that were taught within the School of Policy Studies during Maymester 2009, Summer 2009, and Fall 2009.

4. I have reviewed the School of Policy Studies courses Plaintiffs allege were taught during Maymester 2009, Summer 2009, and Fall 2009. I have checked each such course against the School of Policy Studies' enrollment records to determine whether it was actually taught.

5. Plaintiffs allege that "PAUS8551 – Survey of Research Methods" was taught by Professor Steeh during Maymester 2009. According to the School of Policy Studies' enrollment records, this course was not taught in Maymester 2009.
