## ORDER

This is an employment discrimination action. It is before the Court on the Report and Recommendation [Doc. 45] of the Magistrate Judge recommending granting in part and denying in part the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss [Doc. 30]. [Doc. 30] is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part.
