<u>ORDER</u>

This pro se civil case is before the Court on the Final Report and Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge Justin S. Anand filed August 15, 2017 ("R&R") [Doc. 5]. No objections have been filed.

In the R&R, Judge Anand recommends that this case be dismissed without prejudice for Plaintiff's failure to obey a lawful order of the Court. ¹Since the June 27 Order, Plaintiff filed what he styled as a "Motion of Prevention Her Killing My Children Is Better Than Cure Her With Mental Health Issues, Postpartum Depression, And They Can Be Death-Seeking And Even Suicidal of Love One" [Doc. 4]; however, Plaintiff has not attempted to comply with this Court's instructions.
