




sanctions determined appropriate by the Court. The Court will not accept for filing any proposed pretrial order prepared only from telephone conversations. The proposed pretrial order shall include a paragraph stating the date and location of the meeting, the duration of the meeting and the names of all counsel or parties participating. Proposed pretrial orders which are not consolidated (proposed jointly) will not be accepted for filing without the written permission of the Court. If any party in this case is not represented by counsel, such party shall be obligated to comply with the requirements hereof in the same manner as counsel.

All evidentiary objections and motions in limine which have not been resolved prior to the pretrial conference shall be submitted in writing by the close of business on JANUARY 29, 2015. All responses thereto shall be submitted on FEBRUARY 8, 2015.

The Clerk of the Court has scheduled the pretrial conference for WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2015 at 11:00 A.M., and trial assignment is scheduled for MONDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. At the pretrial conference, the Court will take up any pending motions and will approve, disapprove, or direct amendment of the proposed pretrial order. All trial exhibits (in digital format) and an exhibit list must be provided to the Court at the pretrial conference. Lead counsel for each party must attend the pretrial conference.
