On February 23, 2017, this Court determined that this case was improperly removed by Defendant Kenneth J. Lawrence in that the Court lacks subject-matter jurisdiction. The case was remanded to the Magistrate Court of Richmond County, Georgia.


At present, Defendant Lawrence has filed a Response to the Order of February 23, 2017, which the Clerk of Court docketed as a "Motion for Improper Foreclosure Injunctive Relief."<sup>1</sup> (Doc. 10.) This case is closed, and the Court still lacks subject-matter jurisdiction. Thus, the Court cannot grant any relief to Defendant Lawrence. For this
