## ORDER

Petitioner, an inmate currently at USP Coleman I in Sumterville, Florida, has filed an action under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 which the Court has reviewed. While this action is pending, Petitioner shall immediately inform this Court in writing of any change of address. Failure to do so will result in dismissal of this case, without prejudice.

The Clerk of Court is hereby authorized and directed to forward a copy of this Order and a copy of Petitioner's Motion for Relief to the Savannah Office of the United States Attorney for the Southern District of Georgia.
