

ORDER

After an independent and *de novo* review of the entire record, the undersigned concurs with the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation, dkt. no. 17. Petitioner Jeremy M. Carter ("Carter") failed to file any Objections to the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation.
