

### ORDER

Before the Court are Petitioner's motions for leave to appeal *in forma pauperis* and for a certificate of appealability. Dkt. Nos. 51, 52.

Previously this Court adopted the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation, which advised that Petitioner's 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion to vacate be denied and that any motion for *in forma pauperis* status on appeal and for a certificate of appealability be denied.
