

ORDER

²Because the Court is herein adopting the Magistrate Judge's finding that Plaintiff has failed to state a claim upon which relief can be granted, Plaintiff's request for an extension of time within which to retain an attorney is accordingly **DENIED** as **MOOT**. (Doc. no. 12, p. 1.)
