## **REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

Before the Court is Jermaine Johnson's hand-written reproduction of a standard Georgia Superior Court "Speedy Trial Demand" and an accompanying proposed order. Doc. 1 at 1-2. It was filed in the Northern District of Georgia and transferred to this Court. Doc. 2. The document was clearly intended to be filed in a state criminal proceeding.<sup>1</sup> Johnson seeks no relief from this Court, so his filing amounts to a legal nullity.
