Before the Court are Todd Sherwood's motion to dismiss charges, ECF No. 7, the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation ("R&R") advising the Court to dismiss Sherwood's 28 U.S.C. § 2254 petition, ECF No. 3, and Sherwood's motion for extension of time to object to the R&R.
