## ORDER

Before the Court is the Magistrate Judge's Report Recommendation (Doc. 28), to which both Plaintiff (Doc. Doc. 34; Doc. 36) and Defendant (Doc. 31) have filed objections. After a careful de novo review of the record, the Court finds the objections to be without merit. Accordingly, the report and recommendation is ADOPTED as the Court's opinion in this case and Defendant's Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 19) is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART. a result, Plaintiff's equal protection claim DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE for lack of exhaustion, while his claim against Defendant in his individual capacity is Defendant's request PREJUDICE.
