## ORDER

Before the Court is Plaintiff Corey M. Butler's Joint Motion for Dismissal. (Doc. 114.) In the motion, Plaintiff and Defendant Cooper Tire & Rubber Company ("Cooper") state that they have reached a confidential settlement agreement and request that Plaintiff's claims against Defendant Cooper be dismissed.
