




Although plaintiff's understanding is mistaken,<sup>1</sup> it appears to be held in good faith. The Court thus finds that plaintiff has shown good cause for his delay. Anderson is granted 21 days from the date this Order is served to perfect service on defendant. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m) (allowing courts to order service within a specified time if a defendant is not served within 120 days after the complaint is filed). If he fails to do so, the Court will recommend dismissal of this action.
