## ORDER

Before the Court is the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation<sup>1</sup> (Doc. 10), to which no objections have been filed. After careful de novo review of the record, the report and recommendation is **ADOPTED** as the Court's opinion in this case. Accordingly, Plaintiff's claims for cruel and unusual punishment, medical deprivation, and destruction of property; along with defendants Bynum, Fountain, and McIntyre are **DISMISSED**. However, Plaintiff's equal protection claim against Warden Williams, unreasonable search and seizure claim against CERT Officer Santiago,

religious discrimination claim against CERT Officer Santiago, and bodily privacy claim survive.
