

O R D E R

Before the Court is the remaining parties' stipulation of dismissal with prejudice. (Doc. 70.) The stipulation is signed by all parties remaining in the case.¹ (Id.) ¹ Plaintiff initiated this case against both Effingham County and the Effingham County Board of Commissioners ("ECBOC"). (See Doc. 1.) After determining that Plaintiff had abandoned its claims against the ECBOC, the Court granted summary judgment in favor of the ECBOC and dismissed it from this action. (See Doc. 36.) Accordingly, Effingham County is the only defendant remaining in this action.
