## ORDER

Before the Court is Petitioner Frank D. Monsegue, Sr.'s Motion for Leave to Appeal In Forma Pauperis. (Doc. 64.)<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1), this Court may allow Petitioner to proceed on appeal without prepayment of fees if he submits an affidavit that includes a statement of all his assets and shows that he is unable to pay such fees or give security therefor. However, "[a]n appeal may not be taken in forma pauperis if the trial court certifies in writing that it is not taken in good faith." 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3); see Fed. R. App. P. 24(a)(3)(A).

In this case, Petitioner has failed to provide any meritorious basis for his appeal. After careful
