**ORDER**

Employed as a bartender by defendant AB McDonough’s, Inc., d/b/a “Billy’s Place,” Hillary N. Fitzhugh was sexually harassed by the bar’s owner, co-defendant William R. Lee, Sr., who also maintained a sexually hostile work environment.<sup>1</sup> Doc. 19 at 2-4. Ultimately she brought this employment-discrimination action. *Id.* Contending that the defendant has since settled with her, plaintiff moves to enforce their settlement agreement. Doc. 28.

That motion is before the district judge, appears to be well-supported, and is unopposed per Local Rule 7.5 (“Failure to respond

within the applicable time period shall indicate that there is no opposition to a motion”). In light of the probability that it will be granted, the Court administratively **DENIES** all other pending motions (docs. 17, 21, 24 & 26), without prejudice to renew them should the enforcement motion (doc. 28) be denied.
