**CONSENT ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO STAY CERTAIN
PRETRIAL AND DISCOVERY DEADLINES PENDING MEDIATION**

The Parties having come before the Court on the Joint Motion to Stay Certain Pretrial and Discovery Deadlines Pending Mediation (Doc. [13]), and the Court having considered the Motion and all Parties having consented to the entry of this Order, it is hereby:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Motion is **GRANTED**. Within 5 *but by no later than February 20, 2017,* days following the conclusion of mediation negotiations, the Parties shall file a report informing the Court whether the Parties were able to settle the case. If the Parties were not able to settle the case, the Parties shall conduct the Rule 26(f) Early Planning Conference within 16 days of the filing of the mediation report.

The Joint Preliminary Report and Discovery Plan and Initial Disclosures shall be due within 14 days of the Parties' Rule 26(f) Early Planning Conference. Discovery shall begin on the date the parties file their mediation report and shall expire 4 months thereafter.
