## ORDER

After a careful de novo review of the entire record, the Court concurs with the Magistrate Judge's May 14, 2024, Report and Recommendation, (doc. 13), to which no plaintiff has filed an objection. The Motion to Dismiss claims asserted on behalf of the Estate of Leroy Benton, Sr. is **DISMISSED** as moot. (Doc. 12.) The Clerk of Court is **DIRECTED** to **CLOSE** this case.
