

ORDER

Presently before the Court is the Magistrate Judge's September 19, 2017, Report and Recommendation, dkt. no. 15, to which Petitioner Hugo Ramiro Acosta Loja ("Acosta Loja") failed to file Objections. After an independent and *de novo* review of the entire record, the Court **CONCURS** with the Magistrate Judge and **ADOPTS** the Report and Recommendation as the opinion of the Court.
