

**ORDER**

After an independent and *de novo* review of the entire record, the undersigned concurs with the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation, dkt. no. 23, to which Plaintiff filed Objections. Dkt. No. 24. Plaintiff's Objections are not responsive to the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation and are **OVERRULED**.
