

ORDER

After an independent and *de novo* review of the entire record, the undersigned concurs with the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation, (doc. 53), to which Plaintiff failed to file Objections. Accordingly, the Court **ADOPTS** the Report and Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge as the opinion of the Court and **GRANTS in part** Defendants' Motion to Dismiss or, in the Alternative, Motion to Compel, (doc. 47).
