PETITIONER'S MOTION REQUESTING

COURT TO VACATE JUDGMENT. ) REOPEN PROCEEDINGS AND HOLD EVIDENTIARY HEARING; AND ) DECLARATION AND EXHIBIT IN

SUPPORT THEREOF.

On September 23, 2013, pro se petitioner/defendant John Gouveia, Jr., filed a 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion collaterally attacking his conviction on four grounds. In one of his grounds for relief petitioner asserted that he is actually innocent of the three counts. See Memorandum of Points and Authorities. at pages 16-17. He also submitted a personal declaration in support of his factual innocence and requested an evidentiary hearing with Jose Perez present, so that he could conclusively demonstrate his innocence. Id., at page 17-18, and Exhibit E-1 through E-5.

On July 28, 2014, Honorable Susan Oki Mollway denied his claim of factual innocence as well as an evidentiary hearing solely on the basis of the Declaration of Jose Perez -prepared by his attorney -- which stated: "I will not be a

Mailed On Date 08/18/15-> witness for either side ... nor ... sign a declaration for either side. I do not wish to have any further involvement in this case." Order, pages 16, 27, and 28. (Doc. 519)(7/28/2014). The Court then issued its Judgment in this civil case on August 25, 2014. (Doc. 5).

On or about August 2, 2015, petitioner received out-of-the-blue an unsolicited letter from Jose Perez, which states, in relevant part:

I'm sorry I refused to testify at the evidentiary hearing. I was just kind of scared, but I gave it alot of thought, and [I'm] ready to make things right. I'm willing to testify at a evidentiary hearing to tell the truth. I hope that its not to[o] late. Exhibit A.

In light of this new development and new evidence, petitioner respectfully requests that the Court (1) vacate its August 25, 2014 Judgment pursuant to Rule 60(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure; (2) reopen these Section 2255 proceedings; and (3) schedule an evidentiary hearing with Jose Perez and petitioner present.


