ORDER DENYING WITHOUT PREJUDICE MICHAEL B. KEATING'S
MOTION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

On March 13, 2017, the Michael B. Keating filed a Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice. Doc. No. 149. The Court finds that the Motion is incomplete, as Mr. Keating failed to provide an answer to paragraph 7 of his declaration, which asks that counsel identify the courts in which he or she is a registered CM/ECF user.¹ Accordingly, the Court DENIES the Motion without prejudice.
