**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO LIFT THE  
STAY, AND TO INCREASE THE WORD LIMIT AND SET A SCHEDULE  
FOR BRIEFING ON PLAINTIFFS' FORTHCOMING MOTION FOR A  
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

Upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion to Lift the Stay, and to Increase the  
Word Limit and Set a Schedule for Briefing on Plaintiffs' Forthcoming Motion for  
a Temporary Restraining Order, the files and records herein, and good cause  
appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Court's April 3, 2017 stay of the proceedings in this case, Dkt. 279, is lifted. Plaintiffs shall file their Motion for Leave to File a Third Amended Complaint and Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order by 6:00 AM Hawaii Standard Time ("H.S.T.") on October 11, 2017.
2. The Government shall file its response to Plaintiffs' Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order by 6:00 AM H.S.T. on October 15, 2017.
3. Plaintiffs shall file their reply brief in support of their Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order by 12:00 Noon H.S.T. on October 16, 2017.
4. All parties shall appear at a hearing before this Court with telephonic access at 9:30 AM H.S.T. on October 17, 2017.
5. Plaintiffs may file a brief of up to 12,000 words in support of their Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order, and the Government may file a brief of up to 12,000 words in opposition to that motion. Plaintiffs may file a reply brief of up to 6,000 words.
