A Report and Recommendation (#3) was filed by Magistrate Judge Eric I. Long in the above cause on June 27, 2017. On that same date, a copy of the report was mailed to Plaintiff. Judge Long recommended that the case be dismissed for lack of prosecution pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b). The parties were instructed to file any objections to the recommendation within fourteen days after being served with a copy of the report.
