Dear Mr. Lyster:

On May 11, 2010, I appeared before Judge Cox. I informed the Judge that Champion had, in fact, made four payments and that the Settlement Agreement was revised to allow them additional time. I explained that the prior Settlement Agreement limited the ability to reinstate the case to April 30, 2010, and, based on Champion's failure to pay on time, I had to reinstate the case. I informed her that you had suggested that we enter and continue the motion. She indicated that the time to reinstate the case was extended to September 15, 2010.

I am recommending that the parties agree that the case can be reinstated to enforce the Settlement Agreement prior to January 15, 2011. That would make certain the payments were made and the case can finally be resolved.

If Champion can pay this off prior to that date, it would be helpful. Judge Cox made it clear that she wanted this matter resolved.
