DOCKETING STATEMENT

Plaintiff-Appellant Chicago Lawycrs' Committee for Civil Rights Under Law, Inc. (CLC), by its attorneys, submits the following Docketing Statement pursuant to Circuit Rules 3(c)(1) and 28(a).

A. District Court's Jurisdiction

CLC filed a Complaint against Defendant-Appellee Craigslist, Inc. (Craigslist), in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois (District Court) on February 3, 2006, for monetary, declaratory, and injunctive relief. The District Court had jurisdiction over the Complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1331, in that the claims alleged arose under the laws of the United States 42 U.S.C. § 3604(c) of the federal Fair Housing Act, and 28 U.S.C. § 1332, in that the parties are citizens of different states. Specifically, Plaintiff-Appellant CLC is an Illinois non-profit organization with its principal place of business in Illinois. Defendant-Appellee Craigslist is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business in California. The matter


in controversy exceeds the sum of \$75,000, exclusive of interest and costs.

B. Seventh Circuit's Appellate Jurisdiction

This Court has jurisdiction over this appeal pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1291 and 28 U.S.C. § 1294. This is an appeal of a final judgment and Memorandum Opinion and Order entered on November 14, 2006, by the District Court granting Craigslist's motion for judgment on the pleadings. CLC timely filed its motion to alter or amend judgment under Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(c) on November 17, 2006. The District Court denied CLC's motion to alter or amend judgment on January 10, 2007. CLC timely filed its notice of appeal on January 11, 2007.


