**DEFENDANTS’ AMENDED UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME AND LEAVE TO FILE OVERSIZED REPLY**

In support of their motion, Defendants state as follows:

1. By order dated March 31, 2009, this Court ordered that Defendants file their dispositive motion on their “unclean hands” defenses by June 1, 2009, that Plaintiff file his response thereto by June 29, 2009, and that Defendants file their reply by July 20, 2009. Defendants timely filed their motion on May 29, 2009.

By separate motion on that same day, Plaintiff sought leave to file an oversize response memorandum. Defendants did not object to these motions, and both motions were granted by this Court’s order dated June 23, 2009.
