DEFENDANTS' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE DEFENDANTS' OPPOSITION TO PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR CLASS CERTIFICATION IN EXCESS OF PAGE LIMITATION

Defendant Google Inc., ("Google"), by and through its attorneys, and on behalf of Defendants Oversee.Net, Sedo LLC, Dotster, Inc., and Internet Reit, Inc., respectfully moves this Court for leave to file Defendants' Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification in excess of the page limit stated in Rule 7.1 of the Local Rules for the Northern District of Illinois. In support of this motion, Defendant Google states as follows:

- 1. On August 21, 2008, Plaintiffs filed a motion requesting leave to file a brief in excess of the page limitation. Specifically, Plaintiffs requested that they be permitted to file an oversized brief in support of class certification that would be no more than 35 pages. Defendants did not oppose this request. The Court granted Plaintiffs' request at the September 4, 2008 hearing.

3. Plaintiffs' counsel, Mark Bulgarelli, has been apprised of the basis of this motion. Mr. Bulgarelli has informed defense counsel that they can represent to this Court that Plaintiffs do not oppose Defendants' request for additional pages.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Defendants Google Inc., respectfully requests that the Court grant Defendants leave to file the Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification in excess of the page limit stated in Rule 7.1 of the Local Rules for the Northern District of Illinois, up to 35 pages.
