Whereas, a Seizure of Warrant and Monition issued out of the United States District Court of the United States of America for the Northern District of Illinois, on the 19th day of April, A.D., 2005, pursuant to a complaint filed by Patrick J. Fitzgerald, United States Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois, and against certain merchandise to-wit:

And then and there interpose their claim for the same and to make their allegations in that behalf, by filing their claims with the Clerk of the Court, Northern District of Illinois, 219 South Dearborn Street, 20th Floor, Chicago, Illinois. Any person having filed a claim within the time limits heretofore set forth must file an answer within twenty (20) days following the filing of the claim. Failure to file a claim and answer may result in default and condemnation.
