DECLARATION OF SCOTT HARRIS

- I, Scott Harris, declare under oath and under penalty of perjury that the following facts are true:
- 1. I understand that Fish and Richardson ("Fish") is justifying its review of my communications with my attorneys on the basis of a firm email policy.
 - 2. I have never seen such a policy, nor had I heard of its existence.
- 3. I accessed my emails through a confidential password which I created. I always assumed that my communications by email would remain confidential. No third parties could access my email.
- 4. During my 14-year employment with Fish, I never heard of any instance in which Fish searched the email of any of its attorneys.
- 5. I recall one instance, I believe in 2004, in which Fish searched the email of a paralegal relating to a claim of sexual harassment. In that instance,

however, according to Fish Office Manager Cindy Bright, Fish first obtained permission of that paralegal.

6. I never gave Fish permission to search my email.
