Lawyer sues county over failed prosecution

CHICAGO — A Chicago lawyer acquitted last year in a Madison County criminal sex case is suing the county for its entire annual budget of \$130 million, or whatever amount the court may decide.

In a 48-page, 185-paragraph federal complaint, Meanith Huon claims former Madison County State's Attorney William Mudge and 12 other defendants maliciously prosecuted him.

He said those defendants did so "as a matter of official policy and practice."

"Specifically, as a result of egregious misconduct by law enforcement and prosecutors, Plaintiff, Meanith Huon, was wrongfully arrested and prosecuted for alleged evil crimes that he did not commit," Huon stated in the lawsuit he filed in his own behalf.
