

5. On June 13, 2012 Maritza Ochoa, in her capacity as President of CSG LOGISTICS, INC., entered into installment note arrangements for the payment of delinquent pension contributions covering the period May, 2011 through November, 2011 with the Suburban Teamsters of Northern Illinois Funds (Exhibit A).

6. On the face of the note the maker acknowledged that the indebtedness represents fringe benefit contributions and charges due and owing pursuant to 29 U.S.C. 1145.

7. The Funds delinquency note was entered into for the principal amount of \$4,598.00 (Exhibit A). The maker of the note made 5 of 12 installment note payments of \$341/50 before defaulting on the December 30, 2012 sixth installment note payment. The balance of \$2,390.50 remains unpaid on the Pension Fund installment note as reflected in the payment ledger attached as Exhibit B.

8. The total sum remaining owed under the installment note is \$2,390.50.

9. The maker was given a written notice of default and an opportunity to cure which has not occurred.

10. The attached Exhibits A through B are accurate, true and correct.


