MEMORANDUM ORDER

This Court's July 8, 2014 memorandum order granted an extension to August 22 for the filing of a reply by defendant Scott Carlberg ("Carlberg") to the government's response in connection with Carlberg's pro se 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion in this case.
