AFFIDAVIT OF SARAH RADTKE

SARAH RADTKE, upon being first duly sworn, on oath, deposes and states as follows:


1. I am an employee of Arnold and Kadjan and serve as its bookkeeper.
2. As part of my duties, I monitor the receipt of payments made by employers to the Plaintiffs, by employers who have made payments based on installment note payment plans with the Funds.
3. On or about April 16, 2014, CR2 Painting, Ltd.d/b/a Colour Revue & Sandblasting, Inc., by and through its officer and owner, Kurt Williams, entered into a installment note payment plan to pay certain amounts due and owing to the Plaintiffs. Kurt Williams, individually, also executed the Note as a co-maker. A copy of the note is attached as Exhibit A.
4. On or about May 20, 2014, CR2 Painting, Ltd. and Kurt Williams defaulted on the note by failing to make the payment that was due. No payments have

been forthcoming despite repeated requests that they do so.

5 Upon default, the balance of the note becomes immediately due and owing.


