AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The parties hereby agree that this case has been settled and that all issues and controversies have been resolved to their mutual satisfaction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT :

1. Defendant shall pay to the Plaintiffs \$71,705.70 in accordance with the following schedule:
 - (a) \$17,926.43 on or before April 1, 2017;
 - (b) \$17,926.43 on or before May 1, 2017;
 - (c) \$17,926.42 on or before June 1, 2017; and
 - (d) \$17,926.42 on or before July 1, 2107
2. Defendant shall remain current in its ERISA monthly reporting and contemporaneous payment obligations to the Plaintiffs beginning with the March 2017 contribution report which is due on or before April 15, 2017.
3. Plaintiffs shall stay execution of the Judgment Order entered in Case No. 16 C 5857.
4. If the Defendant defaults on either paragraphs 1 or 2, the Plaintiffs shall have the right to immediately execute on the judgment in Case No. 16 C 5857 and reinstate this case for the sole purpose of entering judgment for the balance owed pursuant to this Order (less those amounts contained in the Judgment Order, Case No. 16 C 5857) plus all unpaid ERISA contributions incurred, accrued interest,

liquidated damages and the Plaintiffs' attorney fees expended in enforcing this order.

5. This case is dismissed without prejudice with leave to reinstate on or before September 1, 2017.
6. In the event a motion to reinstate is not filed on or before September 1, 2017, the case shall be deemed dismissed with prejudice without further order of the court.


