MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

REAGAN, District Judge:

Before the Court is Plaintiff’s motion for reconsideration (Doc. 25), in which he takes issue with certain parts of the Court’s order dated May 2, 2008 (Doc. 24). Plaintiff’s primary contention is that the Court contradicts itself by finding that he is competent to litigate his case, yet pointed out Plaintiff’s failure to comply with federal and local rules when attempting to add defendants and claims to this action.
