ORDER

HERNDON, Chief Judge:

Damarcis March, currently incarcerated in the USP Florence, brings this habeas corpus action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 to challenge the constitutionality of his confinement. Without commenting on the merits of petitioner's claims, the Court concludes that the petition survives preliminary review under Rule 4 and Rule 1(b) of the Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases in United States District Courts.¹

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that respondent shall answer or otherwise plead within thirty days of the date this order is entered. This preliminary order to respond does not, of course, preclude the Government from raising any objection or defense it may wish to present. Service upon the United States

pendency of this action. This notification shall be done in writing and not later

than seven (7) days after a transfer or other change in address occurs. Failure to

provide such notice may result in dismissal of this action. See Fed. R. Civ. P.
