Bacon, shall appear in person before the United States District Court for the Southern District of Illinois, in East St. Louis, Illinois, at 2:30 p.m. on May 24,2012 , to show cause why he should not be compelled to obey the Internal Revenue Service summonses served upon him on June 16, 2011. Respondent shall bring with him at that time the books, papers, records, and other data described in the Internal Revenue Summons served upon him on June 16, 2011.

It is further ORDERED that a copy of this Order, together with the petition, and the exhibits attached thereto, shall be personally served upon Robert A. Bacon, and that in accordance with the provision of Rule 4.1 of the Federal Rules of Civil

Procedure, such service may be effected by any agent or officer of the Internal Revenue Service. Petitioner is responsible for obtaining proper service of this Order on Respondent.
