**JUDGMENT IN A CIVIL CASE**

These deadlines for motions under Rule 59 cannot be extended by the Court. The Plaintiff should also note that he has 30 days from the date of this judgment to file a notice of appeal. This period can only be extended if excusable neglect or good cause is shown.
