## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

## **GILBERT**, District Judge:

This action came before the Court on Plaintiff James Osborne's Complaint filed July 8, 2016 (Doc. 1). On August 22, 2016, this Court dismissed Osborne's Complaint for failure to state a claim and provided him with leave to amend by September 29, 2016 (Doc. 11). The August 22<sup>nd</sup> Order cautioned that failure to file an Amended Complaint would result in dismissal of the action with prejudice (*Id.*). To date, the Court has not received an amended complaint. In light of the insufficiency of Osborne's initial filings, and his failure to comply with the Court's order in the time allotted, the Court has rendered the following decision:

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED this action is DISMISSED. Dismissal is with prejudice, and shall count as a strike for purposes of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). The Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to enter Judgment in favor of the Defendants and against Plaintiff Osborne.
